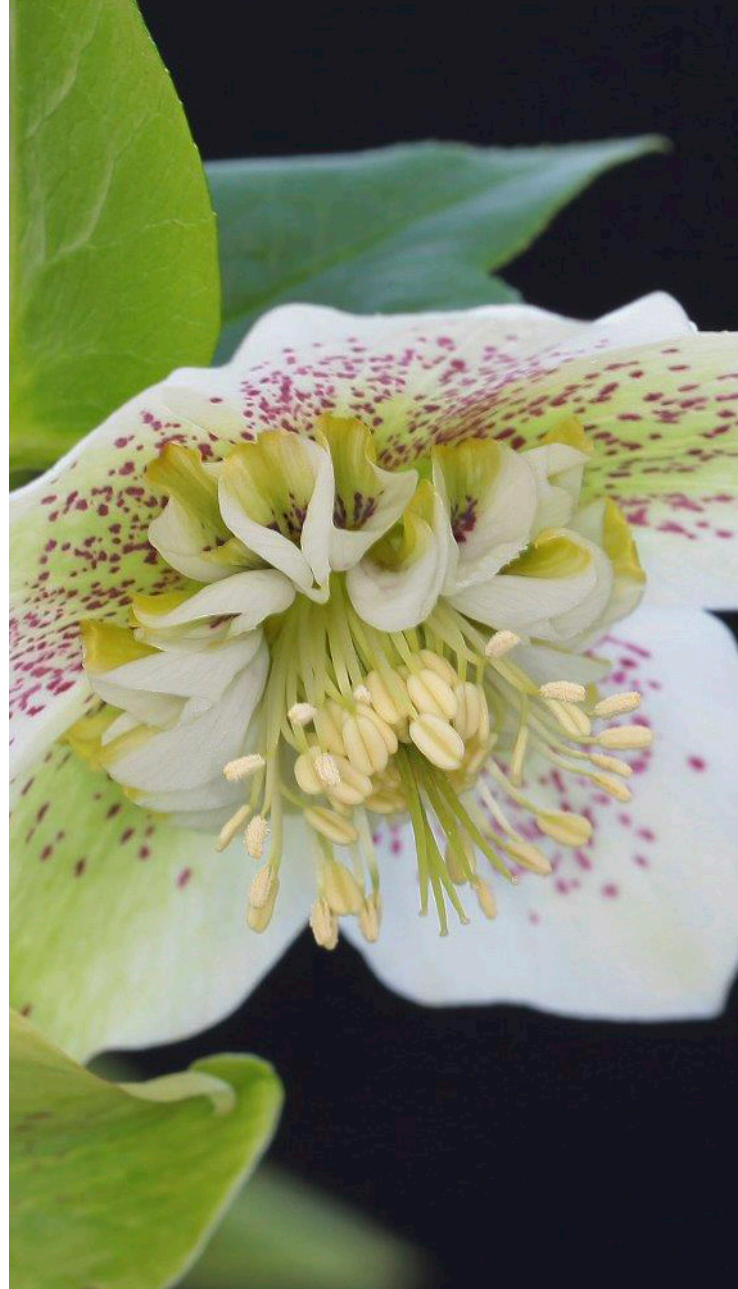


HELLEBORUS

'WHITE TUTU'



'White Tutu' is known for its elegant semi-double white blooms with delicate ruffled centres. Thriving in shady nooks, 'White Tutu' is the perfect choice for difficult and neglected areas in the garden, providing a dramatic and graceful highlight. 'White Tutu' can be kept for up to three weeks* indoors in a well lit room before being planted out into a container or garden bed.

CARE

Plant in any soil that is well draining. Tidy after flowering by removing old flower heads. If growing in containers or full sun, care should be taken not to allow to dry out completely. For best results, feed in late autumn and spring with a slow release fertiliser before and after flowering. **CAUTION: Harmful if eaten/skin irritant**
