CARE

Quite dry tolerant once established requiring only an occasional long soak during extended periods of heat. Grows well in most soil types but thrives in fertile, well drained soils. Trim off around one third of size after flowering to maintain shape and encourage a dense, bushy habit. An application of slow release fertiliser in spring will be beneficial.
