CARE

Low water requirements once established. Provide deep soaks during periods of extended heat. Enjoys most aspects but protect from harsh westerly exposure. Thrives in fertile well drained soils. Prune by one-third after flowering to maintain shape and vigour and to encourage further flowering flushes. An application of slow release fertiliserformulated for natives in autumn and early spring is beneficial.
