The bold flowers are bird attracting, making 'Digger' ideal for wildlife-friendly spaces and native garden designs. With great garden performance and a slender growth habit, it is well suited to multiple garden scenarios and containers. A part of the Wild Brumby collection, 'Digger' comes from one of Australia's leading and dedicated Waratah breeding programs.

CARE

Moderate water requirements once established. Plants are best grown in acidic soil with good drainage. An added layer of mulch will assist moisture retention during periods of dryness. Do not fertilise young plants on initial planting. Allow plants to establish before applying an application of native fertiliser. In containers, use a native premium potting mix and water regularly during the growing season. Fertilise containers after plants have settled. Remove spent flowers after flowering.
