## WILD BRUMBY 'MALLEE BOY'





Telopea 'Mallee Boy' produces brilliant pink blooms throughout the spring months providing the garden with long displays of colour. With the great flowering appeal, 'Mallee Boy' will bloom early in its establishment, often producing bold, big flowers within a year or two from planting. With a naturally bushy growth habit with multibranching stems from the base, 'Mallee Boy' lends itself to being a great filler plant in multiple garden designs. A part of the Wild Brumby collection, 'Mallee Boy' comes from one of Australia's leading and dedicated Waratah breeding programs.

## CARE

Moderate water requirements once established. Plants are best grown in acidic soil with good drainage. An added layer of mulch will assist moisture retention during periods of dryness. Do not fertilise young plants on initial planting. Allow plants to establish before applying an application of native fertiliser. In containers, use a native premium potting mix and water regularly during the growing season. Fertilise containers after plants have settled. Remove spent flowers after flowering.
